



Pennsylvania U.S Senate

Dane & Associates working in conjunction with GrassrootsPA has conducted a poll about the 2010 race for U.S. Senate in Pennsylvania. We used a voter propensity level of 75%, with a ratio sampling of the state based on age, party affiliation and sex. Over 400 voters were sampled for this survey with a margin of error of 3.5%.

The question for this survey pitted Republican Candidate Pat Toomey against likely Democrat opponent Arlen Specter and Joe Sestak.
