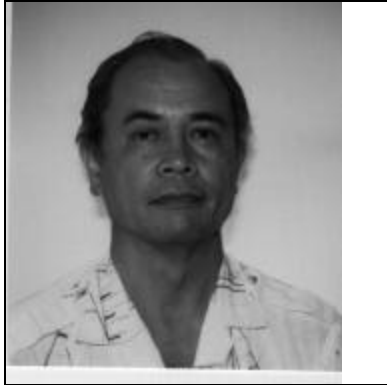

I have a vision I pondered on with my associates for the last 25 years to answer most of the concerns to maintain economic stability for our country.
