Polling was conducted by telephone October 11-13, 2010, in the evenings. The total sample is 1200 registered voters nationwide, including 687 likely voters. The sampling error for registered voters is $\pm 3$ percentage points.
For results among likely voters it is $\pm 4$ percentage points.
Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
