Polling was conducted by telephone October 26-28, 2010, in the evenings. The total sample is 1200 registered voters nationwide, including 764 likely voters. The sampling error for registered voters is ±3 percentage points. For results among likely voters it is ±3.5 percentage points. Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
